

Pastors Thoughts

The Windermere Marathon was tougher than I expected. A few rest days were in order as I allowed my body some time to recover. I resumed running 4 days later with what should have been a short, easy run, but I couldn't resist going further and faster than suggested. I also decided to run in a new pair of running shoes that I had purchased a while ago, that had caused me problems. It was a recipe for disaster and after 3 runs in the wrong shoes, at the wrong pace I'm injured and unable to run! There are 2 life lessons that I've learnt:

Firstly, the grass is not always greener. The 2 marathons I have run so far have been in the exact same model of running shoe. No problems, no injuries. I decided I was bored of them and things could be better with something else, that I could somehow run faster or further with the 'right' shoe. We can so often fall into this trap in our faith, convincing ourselves that we can do better than Jesus, that there has to be another way that would make things easier and simpler, a 'new' way. We look at others and decide they've got it easy. There isn't another way. The old way, Christ's way is the only way.

Secondly, we are called to and need to rest. I knew the theory that I needed to take it easy but the voice of pride and challenge took hold. It is significant in Genesis that God created man and woman as His last act, after all the work was done. Adam and Eve's first full day on earth wasn't a day of work but a day of rest. Our calling as God's children is to rest in His presence, to enjoy God, to glory in His goodness. The glory of our faith is that our salvation is by grace alone, we cannot earn it. Jesus has done it all, we have nothing to prove.

Don't injure yourself trying to prove yourself when the King of Kings has given His life for you. Trust Jesus and walk in His way. Pastor Ben.

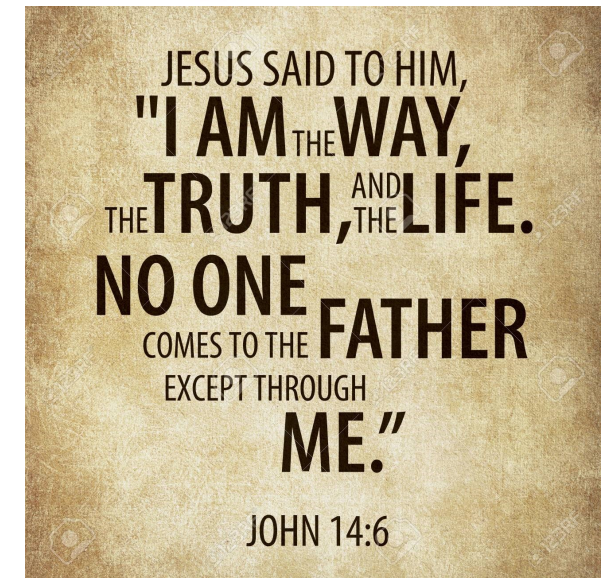
