We will be forever grateful for the way you have all welcomed us and cared for us over the last 7 years. In my last news sheet I want to leave you with a thought about change and growth. The following statement was made during my time at Church in Wales Summer school. **Healthy things Grow; Growing things Change.** It poses the question to each of us and to the church: Are we healthy, growing and changing?

If we are rooted in Jesus then we will find ourselves in the richest of soils that will cause us to find growth and health. That will inevitably cause change as we learn more of Jesus, more of His love, more of His call upon our lives. We will all cope with change differently but it is something we all need to see as a positive. If we are truly committed to walking with Jesus, being transformed into His likeness, being led by His Spirit then change will come. It is change that is to be embraced and celebrated. That is not to say that change doesn't bring pain and difficulty but it brings the reassurance that all be well.

There have been moments in recent weeks when I have wanted to run away from the challenge that lies ahead, wanted to hold onto all that is familiar and comfortable. There have been moments when it all seems too much but in those moments I have found reassurance, in the stillness, of God's call and care. My final thought to each of us is the simple and yet life changing call of God from Psalm 46:10 **'Be still and know that I am God'**.
