

Elders Thoughts

At the last BBC we updated you on the pastorate and introduced our Verse for the Year. Gwyn shared about his supporting role during the inter-regnum (you remember his 5 P's?) and Kevin shared about 'change', comparing the responses of Zechariah and Mary. Change (a baby!) was coming into both their lives but they responded differently. Why not read Luke 1 again? – Zechariah not really believing and struggling with change; Mary believing but asking intelligent questions about the process!

Two themes flowed through the BBC – prayer and change – and how intertwined they are! A number of us might receive the Prayer Diary from MAF (Mission Aviation Fellowship). Recently quoting Abide With Me (do you remember the cup final in the old days?) - “Change and decay in all around I see; Thou changest not, O Lord abide with me” - they went on to say Only Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever, but for us change is often positive, necessary and appropriate. As we ourselves change, we look to the unchanging One. Change means the people of God being transformed into His image ((2.Cor.3:18) His Kingdom coming, and His will being done. (Matt.6:10)

But it's by prayer, talking to our heavenly Father, sharing our hopes and dreams, our fears and failures, that we face – and even embrace – change. Our Verse for the Year says As He was praying heaven was opened (Luke 3:11). Let's be people of prayer in the coming months, praying that His Kingdom will come right here in Kinmel Bay – lives being transformed by the Spirit of God as people embrace God's free offer of salvation. And let's pray too that the Lord will bring to us the pastor of His choice - to lead us, bless us and motivate us to service. The Lord bless you for all you do here at KBC.
