

# Elders' Thoughts

March has arrived with the hope not only of daffodils on St Davids Day but springtime and warmer weather. But who knows - they say that March comes in like a lion and out like a lamb (or is that vice versa?). It's interesting that in scripture both these images are used about Jesus.

In Revelation Ch.5:v.5 we read about Jesus as the Lion of Judah, a theme picked up from Old Testament prophecy. The symbolism of the lion is clear: majestic, powerful and kingly. What a glorious Saviour we have, worthy of all our praise and devotion.

But then in the very next verse Jesus is described as the Lamb (again a theme picked up from the Old Testament when at the first Passover the Hebrew slaves were released from slavery in Egypt). This expression is used of Jesus more than once: *Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! (John 1:29); For Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed (1.Cor.5:7).* These are clear references to Jesus the incarnate Son of God who gave His life for us and died in our place on the cross – sacrificing Himself like the Passover lamb to fulfil God's amazing rescue plan for mankind.

Though we could do nothing to rescue ourselves from the entanglement of sin and the mess of our lives, God has gloriously intervened on our behalf, giving His life that we might live. Let's use the weeks leading up to Easter to focus on Jesus the Lamb of God, and also be eternally grateful that as the majestic, powerful, Lion of Judah he can carry us safely through all the trials and struggles of life to our eternal home.
